

STATEMENT REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 119402

California Health & Safety Code, Sections 119400 – 119402 requires pharmaceutical companies to adopt (i) a Comprehensive Compliance Program (CCP) in accordance with the April 2003 publication "Compliance Program Guidance for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers" ("OIG Compliance Guidance") developed by the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General and (ii) policies for compliance in accordance with the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America "Code on Interactions with Health Care Professionals" ("PhRMA Code") within six months of any update or revision of the PhRMA Code. Revisions to the PhRMA Code were last made in October 2019.

MannKind has established and represents that it has a CCP, and that to the best of its knowledge and based on its good faith understanding of the statutory requirements, declares that it is in compliance with its CCP and the statutory requirements. The CCP includes an annual dollar limit of \$2,000 for certain spending on individual medical or healthcare professionals licensed in California. MannKind includes in this dollar limit the value of educational items and meals provided to healthcare professionals in connection with business and educational discussions with those individuals. This dollar limit does not include prescription product samples intended for free distribution to patients, medical education or sponsorship grants, research grants, or fair market value payments for legitimate professional services. This dollar limit represents a spending maximum and not an average or goal. MannKind reserves the right to change this limit at any time.

MannKind declares that, based upon current tracking and monitoring systems, it is, in all material respects, in compliance with its Comprehensive Compliance Program and with the respective established annual spending limits for the current reporting period.
